BRIEF INFORMATION SHEET

Two events will take place, one for the Scout Section and one for the Explorer Section. These are as follows:-

- 1.Scout Section entry - open to all scouts between the age of 11.5 and 14.5
- 2.Explorer Scout entry - open to all scouts over 14.5 and up to 18.5

The Scout Section entry is 18 Km walking on the Saturday and 12 km on the Sunday. There will be some moorland walking and good navigation will be required.

The Explorer Scout Entry is approx 25 km on the Saturday and 16 km on the Sunday. Tougher than the Scout Route and longer, with a greater emphasis on endurance and navigation.

Map Required is the Explorer Map NY Moors Western Are No OL26

ENTRY CONDITIONS

Any Scout over the age of 14.5 [Explorer] can walk in the Scout Section event [under 14.5] but that team **cannot win the trophy**, only a certificate if they complete it.

A scout however, from the under 14.5 can enter the Explorer event providing the Scout Leader is confident that the scout in question is capable of completing the Explorer event. They **will be eligible** to win the trophy.

Teams are composed of either 4 or 5 scouts. However many enter per team will have to finish to qualify for a Team place.

For the record, birthdays are effective on the 10 October 2008

Trophies/Certificates

Trophy is awarded for Scout Section winners.

Trophy is awarded for Explorer Scouts winners.

The 'Boot Trophy' is awarded to the winners from Haltemprice - Scout Section only.

Certificates are presented to all finishers and those who walk but do not complete all the route will be awarded a 'took part certificate'.
