



Humberside Scouts Wolds Challenge Hike

Saturday 16th Feb 2008

To start and finish in Warter Village Hall (near Pocklington) – Distance 13.5 miles.

The idea of these walks is to allow scouts and explorers to discover the joys of navigation using map and compass. Teams of 4/5 have to navigate between a number of checkpoints – spaced from half to one and a half miles apart.

Food and drink

Torch and whistle

1st aid kit

Survival Bag (we provide these)

Emergency rations (3 mars bars or equivalent) – these are not to be used!

Watch

We will provide the maps compasses etc
