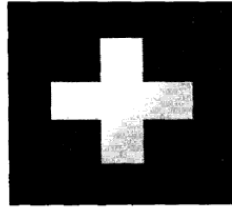


Happy New Year and Its time to start paying!



Summer Camp – 2011 – Adelboden, Switzerland
Friday 29th July – Sunday 7th August

I hope you were able to get the listen to the Rep from the travel company JEKA who will co-ordinating the trip for us. Its clearly fired the imagination as the numbers have gone through the roof!.

The cost of the trip is down to us. There is a basic fee that JEKA charge but that doesn't cover any of the activities. So if you've looked at the JEKA brochure you can double that figure!

COST

I've been busy doing some sums and providing we can raise £12K (it can be done, trust me!) the cost per camper will be around £325. This is approximately twice the fee for the annual scout camp so I don't think it's a bad deal.

DEPOSIT

What we need by the end of January is a £20 deposit per camper to get the show on the road.

We need a further £60 by the end of March 2010.

By the end of 2010 I want all campers to have paid £200 so paying on a monthly basis might be better to ease the pain

So a good idea might be for campers to pay between £15 and £20 a month. I feel its better doing it this way rather than a big hit but if people would rather pay in a different way then please speak to me.

The £20 has to be paid though to confirm the place.

Money will be non-refundable.

FUNDRAISING

I received £1320 yesterday from M & S for bagpacking so well done to those who helped. We have a note of everyone who attended the bagpacks and do not expect it to be the same people doing all the fundraising and we will charge people a higher fee if they do not volunteer for events ☺. We will doing a range of activities to raise money , including , another 3 or 4 bagpacks this year. We also welcome ideas from everyone – especially those who are prepared to turn ideas into reality!

The bottom line is the camp fee will either go up or go down depending on fundraising!

At the moment the camp is full and there will be a waiting list – so if you drop out it is probable that someone else will take the place.
